Opusonix brings together everything a mix project needs – audio file management, timestamped commenting, project notes, and tasks – inside a single collaborative workspace. It supports both compressed and uncompressed audio, allowing engineers to upload and compare mixes in full fidelity.

Clients and collaborators can leave timestamped text or voice comments (automatically transcribed), react or reply inline, and follow project progress without the usual back-and-forth emails. Each project becomes

a living, organized and conversational workspace where everyone always has access to the latest version.

From Single Mixes to Full Albums

For album work, the **Album Planner** offers a complete overview of tracks in one view. Users can arrange sequencing, drop in mixes, and listen to the full album flow with a single click. Opusonix automatically keeps track of revisions, making it easy to test new mixes or conduct A/B comparisons against reference tracks.

The Album Planner also supports **real-time and asynchronous collaboration**, with shared notes and chat built right in.

Integrated File Exchange and Project Management

With built-in file exchange, task tracking, and Kanban project boards, Opusonix eliminates the need for third-party task apps and file-sharing services. Engineers can set deadlines, track progress across projects in a calendar view, and export timestamped feedback directly into their DAW as TSV or MIDI markers.
